**Don't copy others.
Make sure it's your
own work.**

Australian copyright law gives the musicians who wrote the music (and the lyrics) the right to decide who can use their music. It's against the law to use other musicians' work without their permission. You can register with APRA/AMCOS and PPCA if you want to let others perform or play your music on the radio in return for payment (royalties).
